This project will improve conditions for all users by:



- Adding bicycle lanes along Flushing Avenue, south of the Navy Yard to improve access, circulation and safety along the corridor.
- Narrowing travel lanes will calm traffic, improve safety and reduce conflicts between all modes of transportation.
- Extending the Brooklyn Waterfront Greenway.

Parking Changes:

In mid-July on-street parking on the north side of Flushing Avenue, from Navy Street to Williamsburg Street West will be removed.
